RE: Maryland Medical Assistance's Copayments for American Indians/Alaskan Natives (AI/AN)

**NOTE: Please ensure that appropriate staff members in your organization are informed of the contents of this transmittal**

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Maryland Medicaid participants who are American Indians/Alaskan Natives (AI/AN) and are currently receiving or have ever received an item or service furnished by an Indian health care provider or through referral under contract health services, are excluded from pharmacy cost sharing charges.

Participants who meet the criteria must self-attest to the pharmacy provider, in order for the Program to waive the copayment. Once the participant provides self-attestation, the pharmacy provider must contact the Medicaid Pharmacy Point-of-Sale claims processor, Xerox, at 1-800-932-3918 to obtain the appropriate overwrite code.
