Maryland Medicaid FY 2015 Hospice Rates

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) annually issues the hospice wage index and the yearly aggregate cap each year. Medicaid FY 2015 reimbursement for hospice services are based on the wage index issued in the August 22, 2014 Federal Register (volume 79, number 163). Attached are 2 Tables detailing Maryland Medicaid's hospice rates effective October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015 for routine home, continuous home, respite inpatient, and general inpatient care.

The Medicaid hospice payment rates are calculated based on the annual hospice rates established under Medicare. These rates are authorized by section 1814(i)(1)(C)(ii) of the Social Security Act (the Act) which also provides for an annual increase in payment rates for hospice care services. There are some changes for FY 2015. Section 3004 of the Affordable Care Act amended the Act to authorize a quality reporting program for hospices. Section 1814(i)(5)(A)(i) of the Act requires that beginning with FY 2014 and each subsequent FY, the Secretary shall reduce the market basket update by 2 percentage points for any hospice provider that does not comply with the quality data submission requirements. We note that the Medicaid minimum rates would be reduced by the amount of any penalty due to non-reporting. Accordingly, there are two rate tables: Table1: Actual Market Basket Update, Table 2: Reduced Market Basket Update.

Please note the hospice cap runs from November 1st of each year ending October 31st of the following year. The latest hospice cap amount for the year ending October 31, 2014, is \$26,725.79.
